


What we're asking God for

Gospel Wisdom Know About Some Troubling Trends



Trend #1: Unhealthy Assumptions

- "Everything that is called Christian really is Christian."
- "Everything that is called Christian nationalism really is Christian nationalism."



Trend #2: Overgeneralization

- Defining Christian nationalism so broadly that it includes historic biblical understandings of cultural and political engagement
- "Guilt by association"

Top 5 Predictors

- 1.Political Conservatism
- 2. 'Bible-Believing'
- 3.Bible=literal word of God
- 4.Bible=perfectly true, though not literally interpreted
- 5. Religiously "Affiliated"

My Paraklesis For You

Don't give up on confidence in Scripture

Especially important for:

- People 45 and under
- People in positions of influence



My Paraklesis For You

Don't give up on Jesus as Lord

- Of all of life
- For the good of all people

Especially important for:

- People afraid of Christian nationalism
- Politically/socially conservative people



My *Paraklesis* For You

Don't give up on your missionary calling

- Resentment is tempting
- But it is not redemptive

Especially important for:

- People tempted to return "insult for insult"
- Misunderstood people struggling with "gentleness and respect"
